	industrial cockling occurring on Wednesdays and Thursdays throughout the open season. However, it is			
	for the safety of the public that the community council seeks to mitigate against adverse impact from:			
	Use of North Car Park by heavy machinery, parked cars from cocklers that are walking-on and			
	antisocial behaviours behind old toilet block			
	Cocklers accessing the Llansteffan beds via Coal Road or South Car Park that are likely to have			
	large numbers of tourists using these areas			
	Poaching from the closed Llanybri beds			
	It is noted that The Griffiths family trust may choose to prevent access to cocklers across their land.			
	Consequently, the community council seeks to agree an unofficial code of conduct with the three main			
	groups of cocklers.			
	Two risk assessments from James Bates 'Fruits of the Sea' and Colin Macdonald 'Parsons Pickles' were			
	received, and both stated that two banksmen would be employed to allow safe passage of vehicles to			
	and from the shoreline, to ensure safe overnight parking and to oversee cockling occurring on a single			
	tide closest to midday. The community council wishes to thank the companies for the time they have			
	spent with council members listening to the concerns raised.
