(S.Orders were reinstated at 18.48pm) The following recommendations are to be made to the full Community Council: • That we accept the proposals for the footpaths as shown in the documentation
	 That we accept the outline plan for the parking with these additional recommendations: 1. Extend the fencing in front of the bank at the estuary side to ensure that this remains a non-parking area; 2. Grass-crete is considered for the surface of the car park; 3. That there is a barrier to the overspill area so that campervans cannot access this area; 4. That toilet provision is considered soon.
